**SPACE ARRANGEMENT:**

A 30'X30' space in an open area, where people can sit and enjoy the music and is available and visible during the Rally.

**EQUIPMENT NEEDED:**

Electrical outlets, several outlets if possible.

**SUPPLIES NEEDED:**

Medium size PA system required to accommodate a mix of electric and non-electric instruments to make it possible for people to enjoy all musical instruments.

**COMMITTEE REPORTS:**

Provide the Rally Committee final report to Copy Center by day before end of rally. Turn in Cargo Inventory Control Report with cargo boxes (if any) to Property Logistics at end of rally.

**GENERAL OPERATING PROCEDURES:**

1. Consider publishing short article in Blue Beret to explain the Jam Sessions and begin recruiting participants.
2. At the International start looking for musicians and singers among the WBCCI membership.
3. Contact local music stores, VFW and American legion Post, looking for musicians to supplement the musicians already on the grounds.
4. All participants are afforded an equal opportunity to display their talent regardless of the level of experience.
